Simple Mint Water 4 onces Take this every 6 hours 3 large spoonfuls at a time

Annotations

Nitre

Potassium nitrate in mineral form, known also as saltpeter or saltpetre. (Also niter)

Tincture of Columbo

A concoction made by boiling water and alcohol with cocculus palmatus, a medicinal plant native to Mozambique.
