Rx Pulp. 1 "Pulp." appears to an error for "Pulv." (powder), as most 18th century recipes with these ingredient call for "Pulv. Rad. Ipecuan.", powdered root of ipecacuanha. [sic] Ipecuan. gr. i

M[isce] fiat Pilul. ter die ieiunus.
